



Georgetown, South Carolina was the destination for anglers who participated in this year's Georgetown Landing Marina's Meat Fish Slam tournament benefiting Kids' Chance of South Carolina, Inc., a non-profit organization that provides scholarships to the dependents of South Carolina workers who have been seriously injured or killed on the job. The tournament took place on May 17-18, 2013 and reeled in more than \$5,000 for Kids' Chance of South Carolina.

With perfect weather, sixteen boats enjoyed participated in the tournament and enjoyed a pleasant time offshore. Weekend festivities included a pre-tournament dinner at Georgetown Landing Marina catered by Hog Heaven; a lively weigh-in party with food provided by Hog Heaven silent auction, awards and karaoke hosted by Dave Trainer. Special guest, Ebony Bland, a scholarship recipient of Kids' Chance, shared her story with attendees on Saturday evening.

As excited spectators and sponsors filled the Marina, most boats made it in by five thirty in anticipation of the results. The Pain Killer crew came away with top winnings with the Big Dog Aggregate of 82 lbs, 2<sup>nd</sup> place tuna and 2<sup>nd</sup> place wahoo. The Big Kahuna received 1<sup>st</sup> place Aggregate with 83.4 lbs. Nauti Girl was successful in taking home the prize for 1<sup>st</sup> place dolphin and 1<sup>st</sup> place tuna. The Earle-E-Bird crew took the 1<sup>st</sup> place wahoo at 47.9 lbs. Finishing second in the dolphin category was Suzanne Jules at 29.1 lbs. Ford McClary received the youth angler award and Laura Stokes received the lady angler award.
